SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MONDAY, JUNE 5, 2023 – 6:00 PM**

The Council met for a Special Council Meeting on Monday, June 5, 2023, in the Community Room at City Hall. Mayor Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following Councilmembers present: Holinsworth, Crawford, Hart, and Shreeve. Councilmember Cloutier attended by Phone. Councilmembers McDaniel, Bowman and Goodner were absent. Also present: City Administrator Cole Herder, City Clerk Staci Johnson, Nick Reynolds – Humboldt Union, Jerry Neeley and Susan Lynn – Iola Register. City Attorney Fred Works was absent.

City Administrator Herder would like the Council to consider a Grant Application for an Electric Vehicle Charging Station. The Government will pay 80% of cost and a Company out of Oklahoma named FRANCIS Energy wants to partner with Municipalities and pay the remaining 20%.

The charging infrastructure would be the DC Fast Charging. Approximately 100 to 200+ miles of range per 30 minutes of charging. Highway charging for travel, some public community charging, typically, 3-phase AC input, 50kW-350kW or more, over 15% of public charging ports are DCFC, and NEVI corridor charging.

6:22 p.m. Councilmember McDaniels entered the meeting.

Grant paperwork needs to be turned in by June 13th, 2023. Herder is asking for several approvals to proceed with grant application.

Motion by Shreeve, second by Hart to proceed with Grant Application, Partner with FRANCIS Energy, Approval of site location with moderate accommodations and a Letter of Commitment from the Council and Mayor for approval of the Electric Vehicle Charging Station. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Shreeve, second by Holinsworth to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
